What have you learned about your policy problem, its stakeholders, and context?

 What is the (aspect of the) <u>problem</u> you want to tackle?		
 What are potential <u>root causes</u> ?	 Who is <u>responsible</u> for the problem and what are their <u>interests</u> ?	 Who is <u>affected</u> by the problem and what are their <u>needs</u> ?
 At which <u>stage of the policy cycle</u> is your policy issue at the moment?	 What do you <u>know</u> about the policy problem and its context? Top facts, context, existing findings, etc.	 Blind spots: What don't you know? What needs <u>further research</u> ? What aspects of the problem might be <u>overlooked</u> so far?
 So what – <u>why bother</u> ?
